ProceedingsScientific publication

Range of problems: illumination and comprehension of the new facets of human existence at the beginning of new millennium. Particular attention concentrates on the forms of their manifestation and reflection in the philosophy of science, technology and language.

Scientific directions: anthropological perspective of engineering philosophy, historical and philosophical reflection in the postmodern era, anthropological aspects of gender studies, philosophical problems of language.

Information for authors

Articles of problematic, summarizing and methodical directions of original scientific and practical researches, never been published before are accepted for publication in the proceedings.

Articles are accepted in Ukrainian, Russian or English. Publication of articles in the journal is free.

Materials should be applied both in printed and electronic form in the program Microsoft Word 2003 (2007, 2010).

Scientific article should meet the requirements of the 3 paragraph of State Commission's for Academic Degrees and Titles Decree № 7-05/1 from 15 February 2003. It should contain the following elements:

- problem definition and its relation to important scientific and practical tasks;
- analysis of recent researches and publications on the problem, emphasizing of unsolved aspects of the problem, the article is dedicated to;
- formulation of article purposes (definition of the problem);
- presentation of the basic research material with substantiation of the obtained scientific results;
- the research conclusions and prospects for further researches in this direction.

Materials are reviewed by the members of the editorial board of proceedings or by the external independent experts based on the principle of objectivity and from the standpoint of the higher international academic quality standards.

Editorial board reserves the right for stylistic alteration of the typescript. Alterations, which can change the meaning of the text, are agreed with the author.

Editorial board of scientific publication reserves the right to reject articles that do not meet the requirements and subject area of the proceedings.

1. Requirements for the scope of scientific articles, reports, and reviews:

- review and problematic articles – to 20 p.;
- general articles according to the headings of edition – to 12 p.;
- scientific report – to 4 p.;
- review – to 3 p.

Articles of larger scope can be accepted for consideration on the decision of editorial board.

2. Rules for authors.

PAGE LAYOUT

A4 size, margins: top 1,8 cm, bottom - 3 cm, left and right – 2,25 cm are used for layout.

Font set - Times New Roman.

In case of necessity for font highlighting in tables and figures font Courier New (for example, to illustrate the texts of computer programs) is permitted for use. For stylistic indention of text fragments should be taken type style *italic*, **bold**, *bold italic* with a font saving, font size and paragraph interval.

Fonts, font sizes and type face (Appendix 1):

- for UDC, the title of the article - 12 pt, bold, all caps;
- for authors - 12 pt;
- for jobs places - 9 pt;
- for annotations and keywords, file data about a reviewer - 10 pt, italic;
- for body text, links, captions and inscriptions over tables - 11 points;

- for subtitles - 11 pt bold;
 - for References – 10 pt.
- Inter-line spacing - 1; indentation – 0,54 cm

PUBLISHING AGREEMENTS AND STYLES

Structure of an article

(pages are not numbered, hard returns are not used)

Using a language of the original article:

- **UDC** is typed in the first line of a page and left-aligned.
- **Author information:** surname, initials are indicated on the next line, lower - the place of work / study (to be center-aligned).
- **A title of an article** is keyboarded into the next line after UDC and aligned in the middle, without the final point.
- **Abstracts and keywords** are the next (width - aligned). This information should be provided in Ukrainian, Russian and English. For authors - not citizens of Ukraine, translation of the article title, author's information, abstracts and keywords are not required in Ukrainian language. Please pay attention:
 - *abstract* is presented (in accordance with SCOPUS' rules in structured abstract, volume of 150 to 300 words, no less than 16 lines) by one paragraph, width - aligned structured (logically described as the results in the article). It should contain the following elements with their explicit selection: ***purpose, methodology, the scientific novelty, conclusions***.
 - *keywords* – 5-10 single words and / or in multiple word combinations.
- **A main article text.** Structural elements of the article should be set off in semi bold type: **introduction, purpose, methodology, the scientific novelty, conclusions**.

LINKS TO REFERENCES

In the References an author should point:

- at least 7-8 references to the literature sources, half of them - issued not later than 3-4 years ago;
- the presence of foreign authors is mandatory parameter (description of sourcebook - in original language).

Links to used sources are presented in brackets and correspond to the lists in accordance with the following format: first, all references with Cyrillic alphabet from A to Z, then all Roman script (A ... Z), listed in alphabetical order, then this list is numbered consecutively in Arabic numerals. Bibliographic description references should compose according to the standard «ДСТУ 7.1:2006, запровадженого в дію в Україні 01.07.2007 р.» (Appendix 2).

REFERENCES are submitted in the English section at the end of the article. Bibliographic description of references is performed according to the standards of the Harvard style. One should use automatic transliteration systems:

- for the transliteration of the Ukrainian script into Roman script one should use the Decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine from 27 January 2010 № 55 ([http://translit.kh.ua/ # passport](http://translit.kh.ua/#passport));
- for the transliteration of the Russian script into Roman script one should use the system of the U.S. State Department (http://shub123.ucoz.ru/Sistema_transliterazii.html).

The responsibility for the rightness, accuracy and correctness of citations, references and translation is relied on the author.

ARTICLES REQUIREMENTS:

- I. For electronic information. To form all materials in four files:
 - The first - with a text of an article and annotations with keywords. The filename – a name of the author (a first co-author) in Roman, for example, **Yankovskiy_SV_Stattya.doc**;
 - The second - with expanded information about the author / authors (last name, first name, middle name, position, academic degree, academic title, place of work or study, e-mail address, contact telephone numbers). A filename - **Yankovskiy_SV_vidomosti.doc**;

- The third – for all authors, except doctors, with the conclusions of an independent expert (a photocopy in electronic format). The author may refuse from an independent expert review. A filename - **Yankovskiy_SV_recenziya.doc.;**
 - The fourth - License Agreement (scanned). A filename - **Yankovskiy_SV_Ugoda.jpg.**

2. For printed information. Materials are provided to the editor personally or sent by mail. Printed exemplars of the typescript (2 copies.) should be signed by all the co-authors on the last sheet of the typescript. License Agreement original - signed by all the co-authors.
